Day 1, Monday, September 19, 2011
 Depart San Diego, CA for Tel Aviv

Day 2, Tuesday, September 20, 2011
 Arrive in Tel Aviv where we will claim our luggage and go thru passport inspection. Meet our guide and load onto the bus that will take us to the hotel for dinner and our first night in the land of Israel.

Day 3, Wednesday, September 21, 2011
 Caesarea/Carmel/Megiddo (Armageddon)/Nazareth/Tiberius
 Your tour will begin on the breathtaking shores of the Mediterranean Sea at Caesarea. Here you will visit a crusader fortress, walk through a 2,000-year-old Roman theater, and read the account, from Scripture, of what took place in this coastal city. From here you will travel northeast and stand upon Mt. Carmel, where Elijah defeated the 300 prophets of Baal, and take in the panoramic view of the Jezreel Valley (also known as the Valley of Armageddon), and then visit one of King Solomon's chariot cities at the Tel of Megiddo. Your final site of the day is a beautiful overlook of Nazareth, the boyhood home of Jesus. Then we make our way to the beautiful sea of Galilee for our first of three nights.

Day 4, Thursday, September 22, 2011
 Boat Ride on the Sea of Galilee; View the Jesus Boat, Mt. of Beatitudes, Capernaum, and Tabgha, Baptismal at the Jordan River. You will wake to a breathtaking sunrise on the Sea of Galilee and, after breakfast, enjoy a boat ride and time of worship on the Sea of Galilee. The rest of your touring day will be spent tracing the steps of Jesus through the Galilee region as you visit the "Jesus Boat," the Mt. of Beatitudes, Capernaum (the site of the feeding of the 5,000—Tabgha), and then finish the day with the opportunity to be baptized in the Jordan River. After this wonderful day you can once again relax at your hotel on the Sea of Galilee.

Day 5, Friday, September 23, 2011
 Caesarea Philippi, Golan Heights - Our day will include the site the Apostle Peter's confession of Christ at Caesarea Philippi. Israel's incredible history from 1948 until the present will be explained like never before as you stand upon the Golan Heights and learn about the strategic importance this region has played will continue to play to the nation of Israel. After your day in the mountains you will retire to your hotel on the Sea of Galilee for a final evening.

Day 6, Saturday (Shabbat), September 24, 2011
 Spring of Harod, Beit She'an, Jerusalem—Leaving the region of Galilee we go

South to the alley near the hill of Moreh where Gideon took his army to the Spring of Harod. Not far away are the ruins of Beit She'an a remarkable site. Dead Sea, Qumran, En-Gedi, Masada.

Days 7, 8, 9, 10 Sunday, September 25, Monday, September 26, Tuesday, September 27, Wednesday, September 28—are spent in and around the environs of the capital of ancient and modern day Israel—Jerusalem. Here are some of the places we will see while in the ancient city.

Hotels: Prices are based on two persons sharing a twin-bedded room with private bath. Single rooms are subject to availability for an additional cost.

Meals: Two meals daily upon arrival in Israel are included, breakfast and dinner. Soft drinks are not included with the meal but may be purchased.

Registration and Deposit: A deposit of \$350 per person is required at the time of registration. Registration received inside sixty (60) days of the tour date must be accompanied by full payment.

Transportation: Via jet economy class. Tickets cannot be changed once issued.

Sightseeing: Local transportation is by deluxe, air-conditioned motorcoach. The services of an English-speaking guide and entrance fees to places visited on sightseeing described in this itinerary are included in the tour price.

Bring swim wear for Baptism in the Jordan, swimming in the Galilee, Dead

Sea, Red Sea or hotel pool. Do not bring too many clothes. Your luggage weight limit is 50 pounds.

Passports of course are required... do not wait until the last minute to apply for one, or try to find the one that may have been misplaced. Make a copy of your passport to have in your luggage/carry-on and one for your tour host.
